<u>Dixie Region Additional Event Guidelines</u> (supplemental to SCCA Guidelines)

Dixie Region SCCA is closely monitoring the current COVID-19 Situation and our highest priority is the health and safety of our members. The following guidelines will be implemented and enforced in order to help reduce the risk to all participants, but ultimately it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on and off course, to make the decision whether or not to participate.

Autocrosses are open-air events that do not require gatherings in confined spaces. We will strictly adhere to social distancing (6-feet of separation) and face covering. Please understand that our events are not only at risk by COVID-19, but State and Local Government Officials, Law Enforcement, and also the Health Department that have the power to shut down our events if they feel we are being unsafe.

- Please take the health and safety of other attendees into account.
- If you are sick, have been sick, or have been exposed to the virus in the past 14 days PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND. If you begin to feel ill while on site, please remove yourself from the grid or course area and quarantine.
- You are **REQUIRED** to bring your own **MASK AND PEN** to this event.
- THIS IS A PRIVATE EVENT IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO COMPLY WITH THESE POLICIES, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

Event Specific Guidelines

- EVENT WILL BE LIMITED TO 50 ENTRANTS.
- Pre-Registration and Payment Online is REQUIRED.
 - o No On-Site Registration.
- Masks will be required:
 - Within fifty feet (50') of the Timing Trailer
 - O Within six feet (6') of others on-site
 - o NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No Spectators.
- Crew allowed if immediate Family, Housemates, or Shared/Congregated Housing.
- Course Walks limited to no more than groups of four (4).
- Limit Co-Drives (allowed with pre-event approval).
- Participants to bring their own water.
 - o Water will be available, but will not be cooled and will not be at corner stations.

Novice Driver Guidelines

- Defined as Any Driver with Three (3) or Less Autocross Events Experience
- Any driver meeting the above criteria MUST BE PRE-APPROVED before registering.
 - o Requests must be sent to <u>novice-request@dixiescca.com</u> prior to sign-up.
 - If you had a Novice Instructor at a previous event and can remember their name, please include that in the e-mail request.
 - o Failure to complete Pre-Approval will result in a cancelled registration.
- Novice Class or Ride-Along Novice Instruction will not be available.

Dixie Region Additional Event Guidelines (supplemental to SCCA Guidelines)

Indoor Specialty Areas

- Event Staff workers in the Timing Trailer will be limited to no more than two (2) at the same time.
- NO ONE is to approach Timing & Scoring during the Event.
 - o If there are any issues, please utilize proper radio communication channels to inform T&S.

Outdoor Specialty Areas

- Disinfect equipment before handing off between work groups.
- Hand-washing Stations will be provided.
- Cars in **PADDOCK** will be asked to park at least ten (10) or more feet away from each other.

Course Setup

- Course Setup will be limited to Event Chair and Setup Crew.
 - o This will be an assigned Worker Position.
 - o Crew will be limited and will not exceed a total of two (2) additional workers.
- Course Setup Workers will be limited to Members who have been tested and/or in low-risk COVID category.

Check-In

- Check-in will be handled by one (1) person.
- A table will be setup at Site Entry for Check-In/Waivers.
- Competitors will remain in their vehicles as they are processed for Event Check-In.
- All Entrants must sign the Waiver.
 - o Annual Waiver may be presented at the Gate.
 - o SpeedWaiver Electronic Waiver will be accepted for this Event.
 - o Anyone choosing not to opt for Annual Waiver or SpeedWaiver will need to sign the waiver.
 - o Any pens utilized for Waivers will be kept separate until sanitized.

Tech

- Drivers will stay in car while waiting to Tech.
- Drivers will perform tech with guidance and oversight from Technical Inspector.
- Tech Workers will wear gloves to avoid germ spread.
- No Impound for Local Events.

Driver & Worker Meetings

• Driver meetings will be held over the speaker.

Loaner Helmets

• No Loaner Helmets available for this Event.

Competition

- Competitors are to remain in their Grid Spots during their run group.
- Spots are \sim 10' apart and maintain spacing as required for social distancing.
- Masks are highly recommended for competitors when outside of the car and not wearing a helmet.
- ALL CREW MUST WEAR MASKS IN GRID. NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - All crew members must remain in their grid spot and will not be allowed to wander amongst other cars in grid.

Course Workers

- Course Workers will be asked to spread out and not congregate.
- Sanitizer will be available at each station.

Trophy Presentation

- No Formal Trophy Presentation to prevent an unnecessary opportunity for people to congregate.
- Procedure for awarding Event Trophies will be at the discretion of the Event Chair.
