Additionally, if the costs are not paid the Club will also warn neighboring regions of the offender's actions and recommend they do not allow him/her to participate at their events either.

The Region will add "No Burnouts" to the list of things covered at the drivers meeting.

Wilson Richardson gave a presentation of the proposed changes to the bylaws.

Membership recommends allowing the whole club to vote on whether the term limit for the office of Regional Executive should be 2 or 3 years by putting it on the ballot as a separate measure.

The by-laws committee has made note of all recommendations and will update the proposed changes accordingly.

Motion made to for the By-Laws Committee make the changes to the by-laws recommend at this meeting, have the by-laws reviewed and signed by a legal advisor, and reviewed one last time by the committee. If the committee approves the by-laws after they've been signed by the legal advisor then the changes shall be put on the ballot. Motion carries.
